Dear Parents / Guardians,

1. ACHIEVEMENT & ACCOLADES

1.1 Singapore Amazing Flying Machine Competition 2017

This year, there were a total of 145 teams from the various Primary schools who took part in the competition in Category A (Primary) which took place on 13 March and 14 March 2017.

We are very proud of our pupils who had demonstrated much creativity, teamwork and resilience in coming up with the design of paper aeroplanes to achieve the longest, farthest or most accurate flight in the various challenges. 1.2 Reading Excellence Award 2017

The inaugural Reading Excellence Award 2017 is a collaboration between the National Library Board (NLB) and the Ministry of Education (MOE) to recognise MOE Primary and Secondary schools that have developed excellent reading programmes to promote a love of reading among pupils.

This year, a total of 61 nominations nationwide were received for school reading programmes ranging from interactive storytelling to animation development. The programmes were judged on their sustainability, impact on students and innovation.

We are pleased to share that we are one of the 15 schools that were shortlisted from the pool of nominees for our efforts in cultivating a reading culture in the school. We are indeed encouraged by this achievement and will certainly continue to work on enhancing our reading programmes to help our pupils develop a love for reading.

2. UPCOMING EVENTS

2.1 Fruity Veggie & Eye Care Week

To encourage our pupils and staff to adopt a healthy lifestyle, we are pleased to present our school's 'Fruity Veggie & Eye Care Week'. This will take place from Mon 3 Apr to Thurs 6 Apr 2017. During the week, our Holistic Health & CCA department as well as our Parent Support Group (PSG) volunteers will be organising a whole array of activities such as fruit tasting, games and health awareness talks for our pupils.

2.2 International Friendship Day

International Friendship Day (IFD) will be commemorated on Friday 7 April this year. The theme for this year is 'ASEAN 50' as 2017 marks the 50th anniversary ASEAN was first formed.

In collaboration with our PSG, our school's 'IFD World-class@YNPS' will feature 'booths' from the various countries such as Philippines, Indonesia, Thailand and Myanmar. Guided by their IFD 'passports', our pupils will get to learn more about the culture and customs of these countries.

2.3 Sports Day

As part of our school's effort to develop sportsmanship and instill values such as teamwork, respect, responsibility and resilience in our pupils, we will be holding our Sports Day for P3 to P6 pupils on Thurs 13 April 2017. P1 and P2 pupils need not report to school on that day.

School hours will be from 7.40am to 1pm on that day for P3 to P6 pupils. There will not be any afternoon activities such as CCAs and remedial/supplementary lessons on that day. Please refer to the separate letter that has been sent out for more details.

2.4 Environmental Awareness Week

In conjunction with Earth Day which falls on 22 April this year, our school has designated the week from Mon 17 Apr to Fri 21 Apr as our annual Environmental Awareness Week. This is also aligned to our school's environmental education emphasis to encourage our pupils to take responsibility to do their part for the Earth.

Some highlights of the week include sharing session by our pupils from the Green Club and Tinkerer's Club on interesting and novel ways to promote the 3Rs- 'Reuse, Reduce and Recycle' and also conducting simple experiments to demonstrate the impact of man's activities on Earth. In addition, pupils will also be engaged in class-based Environmental awareness activities during Science lessons. Through these activities, we hope that our pupils will be more aware of environmental issues and take more proactive measures to conserve the Earth.
