#### 3.2 P5 Camp GRIT

Our Primary 5 students will be taking part in a 3 day non-residential cohort camp from Mon 19 to Wed 21 Sep at the MOE Changi Coast Outdoor Adventure Learning Centre. Students will develop ruggedness, resilience and forge camaraderie through common experiences. This year, the camp will also include a focus on place-based education in addition to low elements and teambuilding activities. All Primary 5 students will report to school as usual on these 3 days and will be dismissed from school at approximately 5 p.m. More information can be found in the consent form sent out to parents in early August.

#### 3.3 P1 & P2 Science in Stellar Learning Journey

Our Primary 1 and Primary 2 students will be embarking on exciting learning journeys to the Science Centre to learn more about Science through familiar Stellar texts on 22, 27 and 29 Sep, and 20, 22 and 23 Sep respectively. During the learning journeys, they will learn about Science concepts related to the Stellar books read in class. Students will also have hands-on sessions to help them reinforce the concepts learnt.

## 3.4 Children's Day Celebration

Our school will be celebrating Children's Day on Thu 6 Oct 2022 from 11.30am to 1.30pm. This year, to mark this special day and to foster greater affiliation to school, our students will work with house members within and across levels to compete for the overall house champion. The students will take part in various fun and exciting activities such as relay competitions and a basketball challenge. ## 4.2 Students' Safety

There will be construction of a siganlised pedestrian crossing along Bedok North Street 3 near Yu Neng Primary School from Mon 15 Aug to Fri 30 Sep from 9.30 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., Monday to Saturday. The LTA will put up directional signs to alert and guide motorists and other road users of the work in the area.
