3. IMPORTANT DATES TO NOTE


Dates	Event/ Activity	Information
Thu 2 Sep Fri 3 Sep	Teachers' Day Celebration Teachers' Day	School dismissal will be at 10.10am As it is a school holiday, students need not attend school on that day.
Sat 4 Sep - Sun 12 Sep	School Holidays	Some enrichment programmes/activities have been planned for selected students. Do refer to details in separate letters. Term 4 will resume from Mon 13 Sep 2021 onwards.
Fri 17 Sep	PSLE Listening Comprehension	The P6 students will be sitting for their PSLE Listening Comprehension on Fri 17 Sep 2021. On this date, all P1-P5 students need not attend school. Lessons will resume on Mon 20 Sep 2021.
Thu 30 Sep - Wed 6 Oct	PSLE Written Examination	P6 students will be sitting for their PSLE written examination during this period. Lessons will be as usual for all P1-P5 students.
Fri 8 Oct	Children's Day	As it is a school holiday, students need not attend school on that day.
