2. UPCOMING EVENTS

2.1 National School Games (NSG)

The National School Games (NSG) is the largest annual inter-school competition in Singapore organised by schools for schools. This year's NSG opening ceremony, held on Wed 22 Jan 2025, features vibrant performances, talented student athletes showcasing their skills and a strong sense of unity as schools come together to celebrate the spirit of competition. In collaboration with a few schools, Yu Neng Primary School will be hosting the NSG Table Tennis Senior Division Championship. 2.4 Commemoration of Total Defence Day

The theme for Total Defence 2025 is “Together We Keep Singapore Strong”. Opportunities will be provided during CCE (FTGP) lessons for our students to learn about the six pillars of defence and to ensure that Singapore is prepared for crises and disruptions. To prepare our students to respond in a calm, resilient and responsible way, and be prepared for future threats and challenges, our school will be conducting a Fire Drill on Tue 4 Feb , a Power Disruption exercise on Fri 14 Feb and a Lockdown exercise on Tue 25 Feb during curriculum time.

The Power Disruption exercise on Tue 14 Feb 2025 aims to prepare students for potential disruptions to our power supply, given Singapore’s reliance on fuel imports.

Following the exercise, students will participate in a guided discussion to reflect on their experiences and share their thoughts and feelings with their classmates.

Parents/Guardians may wish to engage your child/ward in sharing his/her experience with you and to reinforce the important message that everyone has a part to play in Total Defence. Together, we can keep the school and Singapore safe!

2.5 Mother Tongue Languages Fortnight

Mother Tongue Languages Fortnight (MTLF) will be from Mon 10 Feb to Fri 21 Feb 2025. The event aims to promote the learning of MT languages in a fun and engaging way, fostering an immersive environment for students to learn and appreciate MT languages and cultures. Classroom activities related to MT languages and cultures will be conducted to provide authentic opportunities for students to use their MT language skills and deepen their understanding of their cultural roots.

2.6 P5 Social Studies Learning Journey to the Indian Heritage Centre

The Primary 5 students will be going for a Social Studies field-based learning journey to the Indian Heritage Centre on either Tue 18 Feb, Wed 5 Mar or Thu 6 Mar 2025 from 12 p.m. to 2 p.m. The objectives of the learning journey are for the students to understand the history, heritage and diversity within the Indian community, recognise contributions made by the Indian community in Singapore's development, and understand how the different influences from the diverse cultures have shaped Singapore's multicultural heritage. The P5 Home-Based Learning Day will be on Wed 19 Feb 2025. All Primary 5 students will not report to school on the P5 Home-Based Learning Day. 3. IMPORTANT THING TO NOTE


3.1 School Email Transition
